FOCUS ON INTERNATIONAL ECONOMICS

The main research topics include International Trade, International Finance and Macroeconomics, Geoeconomics, Migration, International Political Economy and Climate Economics.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

Our program is unique in that we invite outstanding external professors to teach up to 8 short courses per year, in addition to the courses taught by our own faculty.

The program charges no tuition fee. Accepted students are offered a 16-months scholarship followed by a 3.5-year junior researcher contract. We also offer subsidized student housing.

Every year we admit 4 to 5 students and offer an excellent student-to-professor ratio with close supervision and a collegial and supportive atmosphere. We aim for a high share of female students.
